Post 16 Transport

You can apply for Post 16 Transport Assistance from Essex County Council if you are:

- Under 19 at the beginning of the academic year (1 September)
- Attending a full time study programme at a school, sixth form or college that is funded by the Education Funding Agency
- Living over 3 miles away from the school/college you have chosen
- Attending the nearest maintained establishment at which the programme, or the majority of the programme, is offered

Chelmsford College Travel Scheme

Full-time learners enrolled on funded Study Programmes and travelling from the areas covered may apply to use the subsidised College Travel Scheme. The scheme covers travel using local **First Essex** commercial service routes and selected **Greater Anglia** railway routes only.

Reminders for termly payments will be sent. All contributions are non refundable fixed fees with cheques made payable to Chelmsford College

- In line with the college parking permit policy, applications for travel passes will only be accepted if you live more than 1.5 miles from the campus on which you will study.
- The travel pass will be ordered during enrolment, after an application form has been completed and the termly contribution paid in full.
- The College will endeavour to have the pass available within 10 days of ordering. There will be no reimbursement of expenses incurred during this waiting period.
- To prevent delays payments for the spring and summer terms must be received by the dates shown.
- The College can only provide transport to one establishment. We will not fund additional transport during the day, inter-site or work placement transport.
- A pass can still be ordered if an application is received after the start of term but refunds for costs incurred while waiting will not be agreed.
- The pass can be collected from Reception but will only be released to Learners wearing their College ID cards. **A passport sized photograph must be provided before a bus pass is released.**
- In exceptional circumstances refunds will be considered. This will be subject to a £15 College administration fee plus any further charges made by the travel operator.
- There will be no reimbursement of expenses incurred if the pass is lost or stolen.
- Replacement passes can be ordered from the appropriate travel operator. Information will be provided with your travel pass.
- In accordance with our Data Protection Statement, the College agrees to share information with the travel operators.

Financial Assistance
