Teaching and Supporting Learning in the Lifelong Learning Sector (LLS)

The LLS covers all publicly funded post-16 education outside of universities. Teachers and those who support learning may work in a number of different environments including the following:

- Further Education Colleges
- Adult and Community Education
- Private Training Providers
- Prisons
- NHS
- Charities

Teaching and supporting learning in this diverse and rapidly changing sector can mean working with a wide range of learners from those who have basic or no literacy skills to post-degree level. All teachers in the post-16 sector now need appropriate teaching qualifications; highlighting the increasing professionalisation of the workforce.

The Chelmsford College Graduate Training Scheme will enable individuals to gain an experience of teaching and/or supporting learners, as well as gaining relevant professional qualifications.

Successful applicants will be fully supported by the Head of Teaching & Learning Development and a mentor, who will be a subject specialist in the graduates' chosen field. The programme will include a full induction to the college, weekly training sessions and the opportunity to complete the Level 3 Award in in Education, and the Training, Assessment and Quality Assurance Practitioners award.

Throughout the year, successful applicants will complete a reflective journal and an individual learning plan culminating in the completion of an action research project.
